

COVID – 19 Statement of Services Changes

Instow Parish Council have made the decision to implement a change to its services to prevent the further spread of COVID – 19(Coronavirus)

The ultimate aim of these precautions is to protect staff and the public from spreading the virus. The measures are in line with the recent government announcements and the Councils own risk assessment.

Outdoor Workforce Service

The Parish Council has decided to close the Marine Parade toilets until further notice. The Beach cleaning contract has been suspended until further notice. Cleaning of Bus Shelters, and associated rubbish removal has been suspended.

North Devon District Council continue to empty the litter bins and the dog bins. They have highlighted that services may be disrupted if there are insufficient staff resources.

The grass and verge cutting will continue as normal as the government have confirmed this as essential work. The first cut will be in early April.

Marine Parade Car Park

The Car Park remains open and all charges apply. Alternative parking is available on the seafront.

Parish Council Meetings

The Parish Council has currently suspended all future meetings. However, meetings cannot legally be undertaken through digital forms, and the Parish Council is awaiting further government guidance on how Councils can make decisions under the current circumstances.
